Jonathan Robinson is the founder and host of Enabled Traveler; the worlds only travel show dedicated to the disabled traveler. Mr. Robinson founded Enabled Traveler due to realizations that occurred to him after being involved in a life threatening car accident in 1996. His resulting hip injury forced him to re-think many things. Being an avid traveler, one of his main issues was finding accessible travel arrangements for his particular ailments. After years of hands on experiences, he decided the information he compiled should be disseminated to others who deal with a disability each day.

Enabled Traveler presents accessible travel options in the same way it's done for the able bodied. Just because you may deal with a disability, it doesn't mean that you have to sacrifice fun and entertainment! The Enabled Traveler television show will be making its debut this year on the Colours Television Network. In addition to the show, Mr. Robinson's organization offers "custom travel booking services" right down to the activities a person would be looking to engage in while on their trip!
