- There are 1,176 people who are homeless in Macomb County *every single day*, including children? Already over 300 homeless students have been helped this fall by Coalition members.
- There are only 157 year-round emergency shelter beds in Macomb County ?
- In order for a two bedroom apartment at Fair Market Rent in Macomb County to be affordable a person working 40 hours per week must make \$15.48 per hour ?
- The Macomb Homeless Coalition acts as an advocate for the homeless and potentially homeless in Macomb County by collaborating efforts that promote and sustain self-sufficiency ?
